The Harman Scholarship:

Bishops' Appeal founded a Harman Scholarship in memory of Desmond Harman and his passion for education. Under the scheme a scholar is identified who could greatly benefit their community through extra education and training. In partnership with CMS Ireland, the candidate studies either in Ireland or in a University within their region (for example if they are from Burundi, they may find a course appropriate to their needs in Kenya) They then use their newly acquired knowledge and skills to benefit their own work and support development within their community.

The first scholarship was awarded to Amos Nsengiyumva from Rwanda and the second was awarded to Rev Cosmas from Gwagwe from South Sudan.
